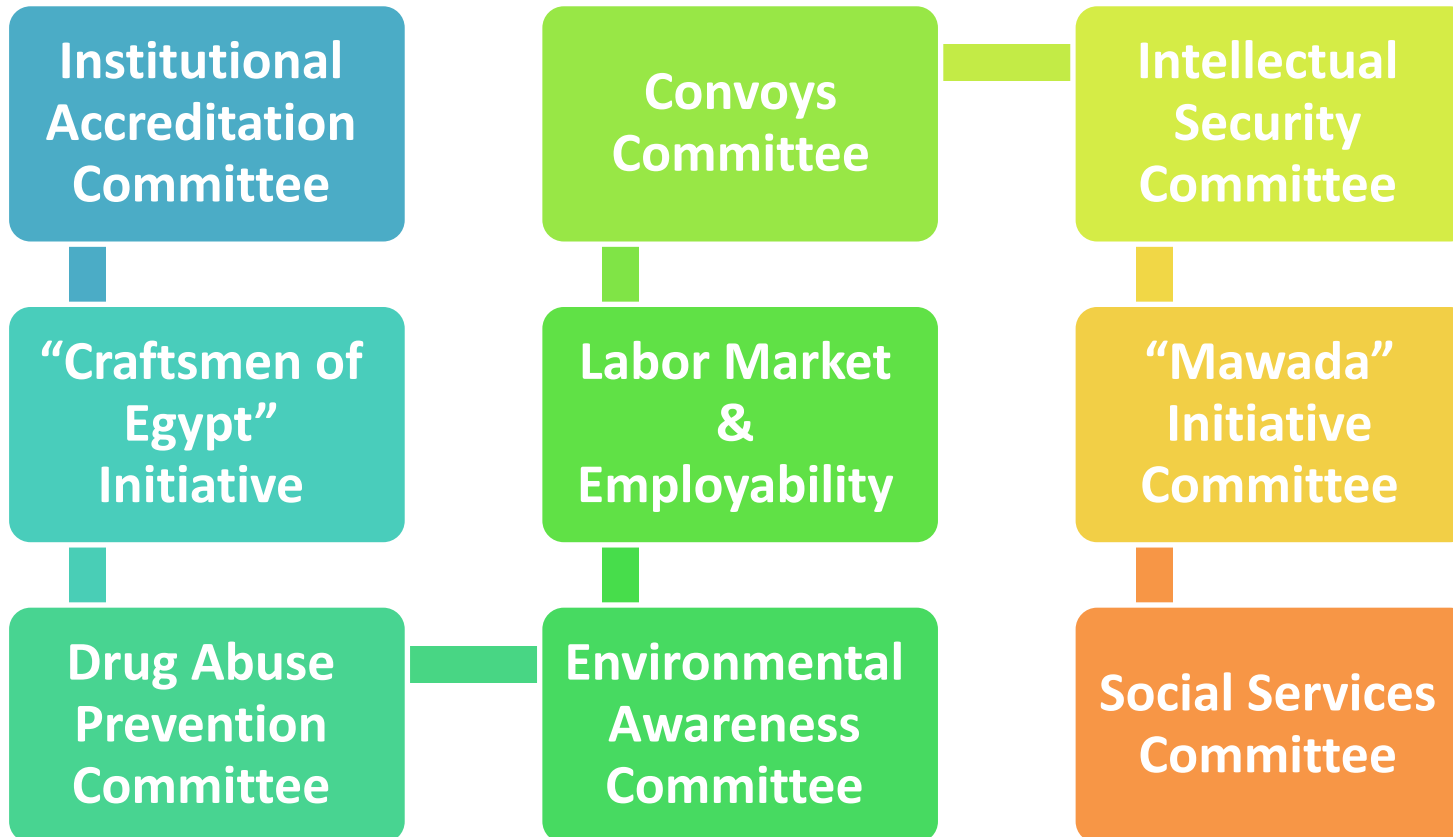


Sector's Committees



Sector's Committees

1- Intellectual Security Committee:

This committee is entitled to combating terrorism and extremism in different ways. It supervises the strategic plan of combating terrorism approved off by the Supreme Council of Universities. It designs programs and delivers workshops which are mainly targeting these topics of terrorism and extremism. Moreover, it organizes events and activities to spread the culture of peace and non-violence among students.

2- Convoys Committee:

The committee implements comprehensive integrated convoys for mutual support and protection. This includes: Medical, Veterinary and Agricultural convoys , as well as Social Awareness Campaigns, and Vocational Training. This committee works according to a schedule approved off by the Supreme Council of Universities and provides a monthly, bi-annual and annual report to follow up on what has been implemented and submitted to Mr. Vice President for Environmental Development Affairs and Community Service.

3- Institutional Accreditation Committee:

The committee is entitled to taking all the necessary measures and procedures to prepare an integrated plan of action for the institutional accreditation of the community service sector.

It also supervises the implementation of that plan after getting the approval of the President of University. It has the right to end its work, see what is needed to review, and audit all the work of the Community Service sector related to qualifying the sector for institutional accreditation.

4- “Craftsmen of Egypt” Initiative:

The committee supervises the implementation of “Craftsmen of Egypt initiative” in accordance with the proposal adopted by the Supreme Council for Community Service and Environmental Development Affairs. Also, it carries out tasks such as following up and submitting reports to the Vice-President of Community Service and Environmental Development Affairs.

5- Labor Market & Employability:

This committee is entitled to organizing job fairs hosted by Mansoura University. It is also interested in getting graduates in touch with the labor market and business sector.

6- “Mawada” Initiative Committee:

This committee is responsible for implementing “Mawada” initiative for newly married couples in Mansoura. It is mainly interested in developing new methods for domestic support. It aims at training more family support workers. Those workers would offer practical help and emotional support to families experiencing various problems. Their role is to provide advice and try and keep families together.

7- Drug Abuse Prevention Committee:

This committee is in charge of protecting young university students from the dangers of smoking and drug abuse. It aims at raising up their awareness through getting them involved in various activities and campaigns. Its main target is to create different sorts of collaborations and partnerships with different entities to eliminate the phenomenon of smoking and abusing drugs on campus.

8- Environmental Awareness Committee:

The committee takes the responsibility of spreading social awareness of the activities of the Community Service Sector among the members of Mansoura University community (students, faculty members, employees of the university), as well as spreading the culture of occupational safety and health through publications, posters, workshops, seminars and forums.

9- Social Services Committee:

This committee is involved in presenting social services to the community of Mansoura University as well as the outside community of Mansoura city. It is mainly interested in carrying out charity activities such as the charity market which is held every year under the supervision of Mansoura University Community Service Sector.
